

# Grand Officers Dress Code 2010-2011



Grand Officers must follow the rules of the Mississippi Rainbow Dress Code for all events.

Grand Officers will wear their Grand Officer Dress to the following meetings of Grand Assembly:

- Informal Opening on Thursday evening
- Opening Session on Friday morning
- Closing Session on Friday evening

During the afternoon session on Friday of Grand Assembly, the following dress code should be observed:

- Grand Officers' t-shirt
- White skirt or khaki skirt
- Sandals, dress shoes, or clean, neat tennis shoes (no flip flops)

Grand Officers are expected to abide by the following guidelines while wearing their Grand Officer Dresses:

- Silver shoes should be worn, in a selection of your choice (but remember that clogs are not permitted)
- Hair should be worn "up", or pulled back if hair is shorter than collar length; hair should not be hanging in one's eyes
- If you have a tattoo, it should be covered at all times
- No body piercings, other than one set of earrings, should be visible
- Regarding makeup, a natural look is best
- Only small pieces of jewelry should be worn
- No coats, sweaters, jackets, or wraps will be allowed on the Grand Floor
- Nail polish should be in a neutral shade, or one that coordinates with the color of the Grand Officer dresses, and should not be shipped
